Bill Jeffrey Collegiate Long-Term Service Award

The Bill Jeffrey Award is named for the former Penn State coach who played a major role in shaping soccer and the NSCAA. Each year, the NSCAA presents this award to a person who has raised intercollegiate soccer to new heights through his or her long-term dedication to the game.

Recipients will be honored at the 2010 NSCAA Awards Banquet, to be held Friday, Jan. 15, in Philadelphia, Pa. A partial travel reimbursement will be provided the winner by the NSCAA and its sponsors.

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Have been an NSCAA member for at least 15 years;
• Have coached or been an administrator at the intercollegiate level for a minimum of 15 years;
• Have a history of outstanding long-term service to and/or achievement in intercollegiate soccer;
• Have made contributions that have had a positive impact on the improvement, advancement and/or presentation of intercollegiate soccer;
• Have conducted themselves in a way that exemplifies the NSCAA Code of Ethics;

- Not be a current paid NSCAA office staff member or a member of the NSCAA Board of Directors.
