Robert W. Robinson High School Long-Term Service Award

This award is named in honor of Robert W. "Robby" Robinson, a Philadelphia area high school coach who has touched virtually every aspect of the NSCAA. An NSCAA Hall of Famer, he is a past president of the organization and received the Honor Award in 1999. Each year, the NSCAA presents this award to a person who has raised intercollegiate soccer to new heights through his or her long-term dedication to the game.

Recipients will be honored at the 2010 NSCAA Awards Banquet, to be held Friday, Jan. 15, in Philadelphia, Pa. A partial travel reimbursement will be provided the

winner by the NSCAA and its sponsors.

To be eligible for consideration, the nominee must:

- Have been an NSCAA member for at least 15 years;
• Have coached or been an administrator at the high school level for a minimum of 15 years;
• Have a history of outstanding long-term service to and/or achievement in high school soccer;
• Have made contributions that have had a positive impact on the improvement, advancement and/or presentation of high school soccer;
• Have conducted themselves in a way that exemplifies the NSCAA Code of Ethics;

- Not be a current paid NSCAA office staff member or a member of the NSCAA Board of Directors.
