



2009 DEMONSTRATION PLAYER INFORMATION

1. To keep the convention running smoothly, it is critical that you arrive one (1) hour prior to your demonstration time.
2. **All players must have the Clinic Demonstrator Liability Waiver form signed by their parents/guardian and bring it with them.** Players without a signed form will not be allowed to participate in the demonstration session.
3. The players will receive adidas apparel to wear for the demonstration. Since this is an adidas sponsored event, the players are required to wear this apparel during the session. Field players will receive a t-shirt, pair of shorts and socks. Goalkeepers will receive a GK shirt, t-shirt, GK gloves and a pair of shorts and socks. Because of the various numbers of players we will be outfitting, we cannot guarantee requested sizing for each player.
4. Your players must wear shin guards and the appropriated shoes. Players without shin guards will not be able to participate.
5. All players must wear FLAT soled shoes, the playing surface will be unplayable with cleats. Please do not bring soccer balls to the convention center, the balls will be provided.
6. PARENTS: accompanying the players will receive a one-time pass into their player's session. The parents and the players will be allowed to visit the Exhibit hall on Friday and Saturday only. Parents will be asked to meet their player immediately following the session.
7. We have both an **Athletic Trainer and an EMT** on staff at all times if an injury or emergency were to happen.
8. Parking costs will be the responsibility of the demonstration player. Please park in one of the lots located next to the Convention Center.
